Please be advised that Ecopower Developments Limited on behalf of Rowanmere Limited, intends to apply to An Bord Pleanála for a 10-year permission for the construction a twelve-turbine windfarm on the Castlecomer Plateau, between the towns of Ballyragget and Castlecomer in north Kilkenny and just south of the County Laois border at Ballinakill. A 110kV Windfarm Substation is proposed for a location circa 4km to the west of the windfarm site at a lower elevation. It is proposed to connect the Substation to the National Grid at Eirgrid Ballyragget Substation. The grid connection electrical cabling will be undergrounded.

The proposed twelve wind turbines have a rotor diameter of 117m. Regarding hub heights, two hub heights are proposed – 84m for one of the turbines and 96.5m for all other eleven turbines, thus giving an uppermost tip height of 142.5m for one turbine and 155m for all other turbines. There will also be wind turbine associated works including foundations and hardstanding areas, windfarm roads and underground cabling within the site. Ancillary works to facilitate the development will include a windfarm control building, a 30m meteorological mast, an 18m telecoms relay pole, felling of circa 21 hectares of commercial forestry plantation, site drainage network and sediment control systems. A viewing/picnic area will be created at an existing viewpoint looking west just off the road at one of the site entrances, which will be provided with cultural and natural heritage and windfarm information boards.
